GENERAL


Application No. 4003 was filed on June 3, 1916, by the G. R. Holcomb Estate Co. to appropriate 8.0 c.f.s. of water from Steamboat Creek for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16; E $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 9; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, all in T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. A portion of the lands described under the place of use are covered under Claim Nos. 660, 669, 707, and 708 of the final decree, United States of America vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al, in Equity Docket No. A 3. Protests were filed on June 22, 1916, by Nick Sorgi and on July 14, 1916, by Caesar A. Ramelli.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 30, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application No. 4003. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "Addressee Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 4003 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit additional information and approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
