GENERAL:

185 Application 8006 was filed on February 13, 1927 for 3.20 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is North Creek and its tributaries and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 10 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M. The 320 acres described under the place of use within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, all in T. 10 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 13, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Unclaimed and addressee Unknown".
