WHITE PINE COUNTY, NEVADA)

GENERAL:

Application 8192 was filed on June 22, 1927 for 1.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is Ludwig Spring and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 18 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. The 100 acres described under the place of use are within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 18 N., R. 62 E.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 18, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Unclaimed and Addressee Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8192 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
