R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Applications 23290 and 23291 were filed by Ronald Floyd and Frank Woner on August 4, 1966 for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water each for Quasi Municipal (subdivision purposes). The proposed points of diversion under applications 23290 and 23291 are within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use under both applications is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter dated September 13, 1968 was sent to the applicants by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. The return receipt card signed by Charlotta Floyd was received in this office. A letter dated September 13, 1968 was sent to the public service commission inquiring if the applicants had filed for a certificate of public conveyance and necessity for this subdivision. Their reply dated October 4, 1968 states that no application has been made by the applicants for said certificate. As of January 23, 1969 no application has been made of record in this office.

RULING

Applications 23290 and 23291 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants failed to submit the requested information and failed to secure a certificate of public necessity and conveyance and the granting of a permit under these applications without said information and certificates would be detrimental to the public welfare.
