

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION 4572 FILED )  
BY WILLIAM P. WRIGHT TO APPROPRIATE WATER)  
FROM LOSTRA SPRING IN ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA)

RULING

GENERAL:

Application 4572 was filed by William P. Wright on September 10, 1917, to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from Lostra Spring for irrigation (40 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and the place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 20, T43N., R53E., MDB&M. The period of use for irrigation to begin about May and end about October of each year. Protest to the granting of Application 4572 was filed on October 26, 1917, by the Union Land and Cattle Company. The owner of record of Application 4572 is Mike Lostra.

A letter was sent to the owner of record on December 30, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 4572. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "Unknown". It is the responsibility of the owner of record or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 4572 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record or his successor in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
