R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 7090 was filed by Webster Patterson and Ed Helth on April 18, 1924 to appropriate 0.025 cfs of water from Mud Springs for stockwatering (3,000 cattle and horses) purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, T. 35 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M. The period of use will begin about March 1st and end about December 30th of each year. Application 7090 was protested on July 23, 1924 by the Central Pacific Railway Company and on July 24, 1924 by Jose Sustacha.

A letter was sent to the applicant on December 30, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 7090. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on January 2, 1969.

RULING

Application 7090 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
