R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 7091 was filed by Charles Drown and A. M. Griswold on April 18, 1924, to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Four Mile Springs for stockwatering (3,000 cattle and horses) purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, T. 33 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M. The period of use will begin about March 1st and end about December 30th of each year. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on July 23, 1924, by the Central Pacific Railway Company.

A letter was sent to the applicants on December 30, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 7091. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on January 2, 1969.

RULING

Application 7091 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
