R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 15307 was filed on September 16, 1953, for 0.6 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is underground and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, T. 22 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. The 40 acres described under the place of use are within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, T. 22 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

An inquiry was sent to the Bureau of Land Management requesting the status of the lands covered by the proposed place of use. Their reply dated January 30, 1969, stated that Desert Land Application NEV. 011942, filed by Elmo H. Ellsworth, covering the lands concerned, was cancelled November 3, 1954. The lands are now classified for disposal under the Small Tracts Act.

RULING:

Application No. 20933 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant does not own or control the proposed place of use under this application and the granting of a permit under this application would be detrimental to the public welfare.
