

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION 13871
FILED BY HARRY RICHMAN TO APPROPRIATE
WATER FROM JUNIPER SPRING WITHIN WASHOE
COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 13871 was filed on October 17, 1951, to appropriate .5 cfs of water from Juniper Spring for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T. 25 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter dated October 24, 1968, was sent to the Bureau of Land Management requesting the status of the land covered by the proposed place of use. Their reply dated November 13, 1968, states that the Federal range privileges are attached to the T. H. Ranch, of Reno, Nevada. A telephone call, on February 19, 1969, to the Bureau of Land Management confirmed that the T. H. Ranch is the owner of the range allotment in the area covered by the place of use.

RULING

Application 13871 is herewith denied on the grounds the owner of record does not own or control the proposed place of use under this application and granting of a permit under this application would be detrimental to the public welfare.
