General:


Application 8122 was filed by Harry E. Webb on May 3, 1927 to appropriate an amount sufficient to water 2,500 sheep from Padelford Creek for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, T. 31 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the same subdivision as the point of diversion. Protest to the granting of this application was filed by J. P. Raine on June 10, 1927 and by R. F. Raine on July 8, 1927.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 23, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 8122. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped "No such office in State". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8122 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
