R U L I N G

GENERAL

Application 7950 was filed by W. D. Hill on December 11, 1926, to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from Hot Spring for irrigation (320 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T. 39 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 32, T. 39 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

Protest to the granting of this application was filed by Pacific Reclamation Water Company on January 26, 1927.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 23, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 7950. The certified mail return receipt card was returned to this office on January 28, 1969.

RULING

Application 7950 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
