RULING

GENERAL:

70 Application 6542 was filed by Jerome Etchegoyhen on August 15, 1921, for permission to appropriate 0.25 cfs of water from Brown Springs for stockwatering (100 cattle, 25 horses and 1,000 sheep) and for domestic purposes. The point of diversion and the place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T38N., R40E., MDB&M. Protest to the granting of Application 6542 was filed by the Central Pacific Railway Company on November 1, 1921.

Application 6543 was filed by Jerome Etchegoyhen on August 15, 1921, for permission to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from Soldier Spring for irrigation (30 acres) and domestic purposes. Water is to be diverted from its source within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T37N., R40E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T37N., R40E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 7, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 6542 and 6543. The certified mail return receipt was returned to this office on March 10, 1969, properly signed by the addressee.

RULING

Applications 6542 and 6543 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested and the approval of these applications without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
