GENERAL

109. Application 5188 was filed by John D. Kemp on August 12, 1918, to appropriate 1.00 c.f.s. of water from the Walker River for irrigation (100 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within portions of Lot 4, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 17, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5188. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unclaimed." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5188 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
