R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 6626 was filed by the Antelope Land and Cattle Company on February 1, 1922 for permission to change the point of diversion of 15.54 c.f.s. of water heretofore appropriated under Decree No. 731 for irrigation, stockwatering and domestic purposes. The existing points of diversion are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M. through the Campbell Ditch and also within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M. through the McCloud Ditch. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, T. 13 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use remains unchanged and is described as within the N $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T. 14 N., R. 25 E.; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31; SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30; S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 15 N., R. 25 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 20, 1969 requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 6626. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 6626 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
