GENERAL

Application No. 9192 was filed by Annie B. Philatro and David S. Jones on December 31, 1929 to appropriate 0.5 cfs of water from Corey Spring for stockwatering (1,800 sheep) purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, T. 7 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, T. 7 N., R. 28 E., M.D.B.&M.


Protest to the granting of this application was filed by Ira Fallon on November 6, 1930.

A letter was sent to the applicants on March 24, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application No. 9192. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Addressee unknown and insufficient address".
