RULING

General:

Application 24556 was filed on July 1, 1968 to appropriate 2.2 c.f.s., of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use 100 acres within portions of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 16 N., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested on October 28, 1968 by C. E. Horton on the grounds that "that it would impair and conflict with the value of existing rights; that it would be against public policy to grant said application and contrary to statute; that the granting of said application would interfere with the customary use of protestant's existing water rights represented by Certificates 4351 and 4352".

A field investigation in the above matter was held on February 17, 1969.

Examination of the area disclosed that the wells outlined in the protest were located approximately one-half mile to the west of the proposed point of diversion under Application 24556. It did not appear from inspection that the appropriation under 24556 would interfere with any existing water rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of a permit under application 24556 is herewith overruled and a permit will be issued subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
