RULING

GENERAL:

(7)
Cold Springs Ranches filed Application 23589 on January 5, 1967, to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from an improved spring located in Cold Springs Valley, Washoe County, Nevada. The point of diversion is in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M. The water is to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes and the place of use is 450 acres within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, N $\frac{1}{2}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T. 21 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M.

On April 28, 1967, James C. Sweger & Don S. York protested Application 23589.

There are no surface water rights of record near the proposed point of diversion under Application 23589.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 23589 is hereby overruled and a permit will be issued upon receipt of statutory fees. The permit will be issued subject to existing rights and will be annually limited to 4 acre-feet per acre of cultivated land from all sources combined.
