R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 24518 was filed by W. J. Cavanaugh on June 3, 1968, for permission to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from Pine Grove Canyon for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 10 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ said Section 32. This application was ready for action on November 12, 1968.

Application 24519 was filed by W. J. Cavanaugh on June 3, 1968, for permission to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from a natural spring for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 10 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is the same as described under Application 24518.

Application 24520 was filed by W. J. Cavanaugh on June 3, 1968, for permission to appropriate 0.5 cfs of water from natural spring drainage for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 10 N., R. 26 E., described under Application 24518.

Application 24812 was filed by W. J. Cavanaugh on December 13, 1968, for permission to appropriate 1.0 cfs of water from Pine Grove Springs for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 10 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is the same as described under Application 24518.

Applications 24519 and 24520 were protested by the U.S.A. - Forest Service on October 24, 1968. Application 24812 was protested by the U.S.A. - Forest Service on May 10, 1969. There are no other rights of record in this office from these sources.

RULING

The protests against Application 24519, 24520, and 24812, are herewith overruled and permits will be granted subject to existing rights under these applications, upon receipt of the statutory permit fees. These permits will not extend to the permittee the right to ingress and egress on public or corporate lands.
