GENERAL:

117 Application 18884 was filed by Paul Kollsman on May 31, 1960, for permission to appropriate 1.2 c.f.s. of water from Trail Creek for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T.1S., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed). The proposed place of use is described as the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.1S., R.33E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed).

The point of diversion described in Application 18884 is a collection box in the natural channel of Trail Creek and is the same point of diversion as Permits 10856, 16424, 17175 and 17176, as evidenced by a field investigation made on June 15, 1960.

There are two permitted rights in the name of Hubert H. Wakeham for a total of 0.0050 c.f.s. of water from Trail Creek for stock watering purposes.

All other permitted rights from Trail Creek are presently in the name of Paul Kollsman.

RULING

A permit will be issued under Application 18884, upon receipt of the statutory fee, subject to all existing rights. The granting of a permit under this application does not constitute the granting of rights of ingress or egress to the applicant.
