

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 13700 )

APPROPRIATE UNDERGROUND WATER IN LAS : RULING  
VEGAS VALLEY, CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA. )

Application No. 13700 was filed on May 3, 1951 to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of underground water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 30, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. and the proposed place of use is 100 acres of land in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 30, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.M.

The notice of this application was duly published in the Las Vegas Review-Journal, a daily newspaper of general circulation in Clark County, Nevada, as prescribed by law. No protests to the granting of a permit under said application were filed.

Action by the Bureau of Land Management:


The land to be irrigated under Application No. 13700 was applied for through the Nevada Land and Survey office of the Bureau of Land Management under Homestead Entry, Nev. 05533.

On August 13, 1952 the Homestead Entry of Lynn Roscoe Scott was rejected and finally closed by the Bureau of Land Management.

RULING

Application No. 13700 to appropriate underground water by Lynn Roscoe Scott is denied on the grounds that the land on which such water was to be appurtenant is not available to applicant.
