R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 8163 was filed by James Doutre on June 11, 1927 for permission to appropriate 0.025 cfs of water from Trough Springs for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 25 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M. The applicant proposed to water 2,000 head of sheep.


A protest was filed by B. H. Robison on October 27, 1927 on the grounds that "that right to said Trough Springs---were purchased by B. H. Robison from Owner Chester H. Larsen---and further that the protestant B. H. Robison has been using said springs during the grazing season of 1927".

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on September 29, 1969, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt signed by James Doutre was received in this office on October 3, 1969. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

Application No. 8163 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit without the said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
