GENERAL:


Application 6705 was filed by G. Edgar Nesbitt on June 23, 1922, for permission to appropriate 2 second feet of water from Hiko Lake for irrigation purposes. The proposed point of diversion was described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 4 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as 150 acres within portions of Sections 22, 26, and 27, all in T. 4 S., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested on October 20, 1922, by M. F. Schofield and W. U. Schofield and W. J. Schofield.

A letter was sent to the owner of record on June 22, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on this application. A return receipt signed by George E. Nesbitt was received in this office on July 11, 1969. No reply has been received to this letter.

RULING

Application 6705 is herewith denied on the grounds that the owner of record failed to submit the required information.
