R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 8536 was filed by L. E. McCulley on May 12, 1928, for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Sheep Camp Spring for stock watering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 2, T.43N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed under this application by Frank Bowers on April 5, 1929. No further action has been taken on this application since that time.

A letter was sent to the applicant on April 8, 1970, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Deceased" and "Moved, Not Forwardable" by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 8536 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
