FILED BY JOE CASTILLO FOR PERMISSION TO
APPROPRIATE WATER FROM SHELL CREEK IN
WHITE PINE COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

GENERAL:

7) Application No. 9526 was filed by Joe Castillo on September 17, 1931 for permission to appropriate 2.0 cfs of water from Shell Creek for watering 500 head of cattle and horses and 2,000 sheep. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, T. 22 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was protested by James Katsoras on August 5, 1932. No further action has been taken since that time.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on July 11, 1969 requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned "unclaimed".

RULING

Application No. 9526 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
