GENERAL: 107

Application 26080 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25047. The application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The point of diversion is described as being in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. The existing point of diversion is described as being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is some 11,000 acres described under Exhibit A attached to the application. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26082 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25048. This application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The existing point of diversion is described as being in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26084 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25044. This application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 24, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The existing point of diversion is described as being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use of this application is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26085 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25043. This application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as

being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The existing point of diversion is described as being located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26086 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25040. This application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26087 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25041. This application proposes to change 5.4 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 20 S., R. 54 E. The existing point of diversion is described as being located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26088 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25042. This application proposes to change 6.0 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 30, T. 20 S., R. 54 E. The existing point of diversion is described as being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Application 26089 was filed on April 26, 1971 to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 25049. This application proposes to change 3.9 c.f.s. of water from irrigation and domestic to quasi-municipal and domestic. The proposed point of diversion is described as being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The existing point of diversion is within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22, T. 20 S., R. 53 E. The proposed place of use is the same as that described under Application 26080. This application was ready for action on July 12, 1971.

Ruling

Moving the location of the points of diversion as applied for in the subject applications would result in withdrawing additional quantities of water from a more critical ground water area.

Applications 26080, 26082, 26084, 26085, 26086, 26087, 26088, and 26089 are denied on the grounds that the proposed change of the point of diversion would adversely affect existing water rights.
