R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 16843 was filed January 24, 1956, by Orville Jackson to appropriate 0.025 c.f.s. of water from Richmond Spring in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec. 19, T.19N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M. for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The place of use is the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec.24, T.19N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest to the granting of this application was filed in this office on April 27, 1956 by Heller's Eureka Water Works. The grounds of the protest were that the protestant had acquired a vested right and that the granting of a permit would adversely affect prior existing rights.

A field investigation in the matter of this application was held on July 9, 1956. At that time it was determined that more information was necessary before action could be taken.

A letter was forwarded to the applicant on November 16, 1966, requesting information necessary before further action could be taken on this application. On November 28, 1966, the letter and envelope were returned to this office by the U.S. Post Office. The envelope was stamped "Deceased."

RULING

Application 16843 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
