GENERAL:

Application 26273 was filed by Ash Springs Development Corporation for permission to appropriate 18.5 c.f.s. of water from Ash Springs for recreational purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.6S., R.60E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

Protests were filed by Ash Spring Water Users on December 23, 1971, and Kenneth Wadsworth on January 1, 1972. The protests were overruled by our Ruling No. 1898, and a notice for permit fees was forwarded to the applicant on April 4, 1973. No reply was received to said notice.

A letter was forwarded to the applicant on May 4, 1973, by certified mail requesting permit fees due under this application. A return receipt was received in this office showing delivery of said letter of May 7, 1973. No reply has been received in this office.

RULING

Application 26273 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the permit fees required in accordance with NRS 533.435.
