R U L I N G

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GENERAL:

Application 27765 was filed on September 14, 1973, by Marvin L. Anderson to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source to be diverted within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B. & M., to be used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 3 to furnish water for approximately 10 residences.

This area was designated on January 22, 1973 by order of the State Engineer. Present information available indicates that the estimated perennial yield of the Dayton Valley ground water basin is 7900 acre feet. Existing water rights of record within the Dayton Valley underground basin exceed the estimate of perennial yield.

RULING:

Application 27765 is hereby denied on the grounds that the granting of this application for additional withdrawal of water from this area of the Dayton Valley ground water basin would adversely affect and tend to impair the value of existing water rights.
