R U L I N G

Application 25733 was filed on July 29, 1970, by R. W. Webb to change the place of use of a portion of the water heretofore appropriated under Permit 22559. Permit 22559 was issued for 1.0 c.f.s. for the irrigation of 43 acres of land. Application 25733 seeks to change 0.581 c.f.s. and 25 acres granted under Permit 22559 to lands more readily adaptable to irrigation. This application was not protested.

Application 26314 was filed on September 15, 1971, by R. W. Webb to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Application 25733. This application seeks to change 0.302 c.f.s. and 13.0 acres of land if Application 25733 is granted.

Application 26315 was filed on September 15, 1971, by R. W. Webb to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters sought to be changed by Application 25733. This application is in the amount of 0.279 c.f.s. for the irrigation of 12 acres of land.

Application 26313 was filed on September 15, 1971, by R. W. Webb to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 22559. Application 26313 seeks to change 0.302 c.f.s. and 13 acres of land, as granted under Permit 22559.

These applications were protested by the Muddy Valley Irrigation Company and were the subject of a field investigation held on July 28, 1971, and numerous informal discussions with the applicant and the protestants since that time.

OPINION:

It is our opinion that the granting of these applications to change will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. The granting of these permits does not allow additional water or expanded acreages.

RULING:

The protests against the granting of Applications 26313, 26314 and 26315 are hereby overruled on the grounds that their granting will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. No protest was filed against the granting of Application 25733 and it will, therefore, be granted.
