R U L I N G

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GENERAL:


Application 26136 was filed May 19, 1971 by Standard Resources, Inc. to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. from an underground source located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T.25N., R.24E., to be used for mining and milling purposes within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9 and E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.25N., R.24E. Application 26136 became ready for action on January 17, 1972. No protests to the granting of Application 26136 were filed.

Research of the records of the State Engineer's office indicates that the point of diversion under Application 26136 is the same underground source on which there exists Permit 11019, Certificate 2809, in the name of M. G. L. Mining Corp. By letter of April 30, 1975 to Standard Resources, Inc. it was requested that clarification of ownership of this well be submitted in addition to requesting information on the anticipated weekly, monthly or annual consumptive use proposed by Application 26136. No reply to this letter was received. On June 3, 1975 a certified letter was mailed to Standard Resources, Inc. requesting a response to the first letter of April 30, 1975. A properly endorsed receipt for this certified letter was returned to the State Engineer's office on June 5, 1975. As of this date, no reply has been received.

RULING:

Application 26136 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit sufficient information for the issuance of a permit.
