GENERAL:


Application 28680 was filed September 12, 1974 in the name of Comstock Six Placer, Inc. to appropriate 5.0 c.f.s. from an underground source located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 21, T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M. to be used for mining, milling and domestic purposes within portions of Sections 21, 28, 25 and 26 all in T.14N., R.67E., M.D.B.&M. Application 28680 became ready for action December 9, 1974.

By letter of February 7, 1975 Mr. Kenneth H. Bradley, agent for Comstock Six Placer, Inc. was requested to inform the State Engineer's Office of the anticipated annual consumptive use of water. No reply was received and by certified letter of March 18, 1975 Mr. Bradley was again requested to submit the necessary information. A properly endorsed receipt for this letter was received by the State Engineer's Office on March 28, 1975. No reply was received and by certified letter of August 21, 1975, Mr. Bradley was once more requested to inform the State Engineer's Office of the anticipated consumptive use. A properly endorsed receipt for this letter was returned to the State Engineer's Office on August 25, 1975. As of the date of this ruling, no reply to this letter has been received.

RULING:

Application 28680 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit information necessary for the issuance of a permit.
