R U L I N G

GENERAL:

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was received in this office on April 22, 1975, with the statutory \$25.00 filing fee from Russell Kenison, P. O. Box 207, Winnemucca, Nevada. Receipt No. 4138 for the \$25.00 fee was issued on April 22, 1975, to Mrs. Susan Kenison.

Requests for references were forwarded to four (4) persons as listed on the application on April 23, 1975.

The applicant was advised by certified mail dated June 26, 1975, that a time was scheduled on the agenda to appear for an oral interview before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board meeting on July 11, 1975. The applicant failed to appear before the Advisory Board as scheduled.

The applicant was advised a second time by certified mail dated September 25, 1975, that a time was scheduled on the agenda to appear for an oral interview before the Advisory Board meeting on October 10, 1975. The applicant again failed to appear before the Advisory Board as scheduled.

The applicant was advised for the third time by certified mail dated January 21, 1976, that a time was scheduled on the February 6, 1976 agenda to appear for an oral interview before the Advisory Board and also by this letter was requested to express an interest in obtaining a Nevada well driller's license. The applicant again failed to appear as scheduled before the Advisory Board and no communication was received to express an interest.

RULING

The application of Russell Kenison for a Nevada well driller's license is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear before the Statewide

Well Drillers' Advisory Board for an oral interview and, therefore, it cannot be determined that the applicant has sufficient knowledge and experience to qualify as a well driller.
