GENERAL:

Application 29604 was filed on August 27, 1975 in the name of Sylvia G. Tait to appropriate 2.0 c.f.s. from Camp Creek and Tributaries, to be diverted within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.5N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M. for the irrigation of 100 acres within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 20 T.5N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest to the granting of Application 29604 was filed on January 29, 1976 by Wayne Pearson on the grounds that "there is not enough water to supply our water applications". The protest seeks denial of Application 29604.

Application 28449 for the waters of an Unnamed Spring, which is a tributary to Camp Creek, had been previously filed by Sylvia G. Tait and was likewise protested by Wayne Pearson. A field investigation into the matter of Application 28449 was conducted on May 15, 1975, during which sufficient information was gathered to allow a ruling on protested Application 29604 (refer to Report of Field Investigation No. 525 dated June 11, 1975). As a result of that field investigation, it has been determined that there is sufficient unappropriated water available in Camp Creek and its tributaries to support the use as applied for under Application 29604.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 29604 is herewith overruled and a permit will be granted subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fees.
