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RULING

It is the opinion of the State Engineer that because of the distance (from one to approximately three miles) between the permits of the Protestants and the location of the proposed wells of the Applicant, that no undue interference is possible.

It is also the opinion of the State Engineer that the prior rights of the Protestants are adequately protected by the ground-water statutes should a general lowering of the water table take place.

RULING

The protests of Rubicon Properties, Inc., and Mr. S. T. Clarke are overruled and permits will be granted under Applications Nos. 16360, 16361 and 16362 subject to existing rights.
