R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 30382 was filed on July 8, 1976 by Shirley Newton to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T.17N., R.19E., M.D.M. The place of use is described as within the same 40-acre subdivision as the point of diversion. The period of use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The applicant states that the water will serve single (6) family residences and an antique shop.

A protest to the granting of Application 30382 was filed on November 30, 1976 by John R. Taylor on the grounds that there is insufficient water to provide for service as described by the applicant.


OPINION:

It is the opinion of the State Engineer that the granting of Application 30382 will not tend to impair the value of existing prior rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING:

The protest to the granting of Application 30382 is hereby overruled on the grounds that the granting will not tend to impair the value of existing rights and be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be granted to Application 30382 upon receipt of the permit fees.
