GENERAL

An application for a Water Well Drillers License was filed on July 17, 1981 by Chester U. Kile; Receipt No. 6725 was issued to Mr. Kile. A request for references concerning Mr. Kile's drilling experience was mailed on July 21, 1981. Three of the five requests were returned to this office completed as required. The minimum number of references required is four.

A notice was sent on September 16, 1981 to Mr. Kile by certified mail requesting additional references and to appear on October 1, 1981 before the Statewide Well Drillers Advisory Board for an oral interview to determine the applicant's experience as a water well driller. The certified mail receipt card was received in this office on September 24, 1981, signed by Mr. Kile.

The applicant was further notified on September 16, 1981 to notify this office if he could not appear before the Statewide Well Drillers Advisory Board.

CONCLUSION

Mr. Kile did not notify this office that he would not appear. It is assumed that the applicant is not interested in obtaining a Water Well Drillers License at this time.

The Statewide Well Drillers Advisory Board recommended that Mr. Kile's license be denied.

RULING

A Water Well Drillers License is herewith denied to Mr. Kile as he has not substantiated his experience or ability as a Water Well Driller to the Division of Water Resources nor the Statewide Well Drillers Advisory Board. The applicant may reapply at his convenience.
