

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO.
17093 ON NOVEMBER 14, 1956 BY
JAMES W. KINNEY, TO APPROPRIATE
UNDERGROUND WATER FOR IRRIGATION
AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES IN HUMBOLDT
COUNTY, NEVADA. THIS APPLICATION
WAS PROTESTED ON FEBRUARY 15, 1957
BY THE PERSHING COUNTY WATER CON-
SERVATION DISTRICT OF NEVADA.

RULING

General:

70 Application No. 17093 was filed on November 14,
1956 by James W. Kinney to appropriate 1.5 c.f.s. of water
from an underground source, within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20,
T. 36 N., R. 38 E., M.B.D.&M.

A protest to the granting of said application
was filed on February 15, 1957 by the Pershing County Water
Conservation District of Nevada, on grounds that the grant-
ing of said application would effect the decreed water of
the Humboldt River.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No.
17093 is herewith overruled on grounds that the granting
of said application will not impair the value of existing
rights or otherwise be detrimental to the public welfare.
