

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS NOS. 13701,

RULING

General:

Protests to the granting of these applications  
were filed on September 6, 1951 by A. G. McBride on  
grounds that the waters are within an area in which the  
protestant is entitled to graze.

RULING

The protests to the granting of these applica-  
tions are herewith overruled on the grounds that the  
waters are in the allotted grazing area of the applicant  
which is confined to the west slope of Antelope Range  
and will not interfere with any existing range rights.  
Permits will be issued under Applications Nos. 13701,  
13702 and 13704 upon the receipt of the statutory permit  
fees.
