RULING

General:

50 A protest to the granting of the application was filed on November 13, 1951, by A. G. McBride on grounds that the waters are within an area in which the protestant is entitled to graze. Upon investigation, it was found that the waters are within area allotted to the applicant for grazing purposes.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 13815 is herewith overruled on grounds that the granting thereof will not interfere with any existing water right of the protestant. A permit will be issued under Application No. 13815, upon the receipt of the statutory permit fee.
