RULING

GENERAL

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was filed by Ernest F. Gray, Jr., in the Office of the State Engineer on January 8, 1986, together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 8406 was issued to Paul E. Williams for said filing fee.

Requests for 5 references were mailed on January 8, 1986. A response was received from 1 of the individuals. The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 10, 1986, and July 10, 1986. The applicant did appear and the Board recommended that he return at the next meeting.

The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 15, 1986. The applicant did not appear and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear as requested by said notice.


CONCLUSIONS

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommends denial of the application of Ernest F. Gray, Jr..
