RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada well driller's license was filed by Rodney D. Aders in the Office of the State Engineer on May 23, 1990, together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10210 was issued to Lang Exploratory Drilling for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on May 23, 1990. A response was received from four of the individuals. The applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 12, 1990 at 3:00 P.M. in Las Vegas Nevada, and the Board recommended the State Engineer Deny the license application on the grounds the applicant failed to demonstrate a sufficient knowledge of the regulation.

The State Engineer then decided to re-schedule the applicant for the next examination. the applicant was notified by certified mail to appear before the Board on January 11, 1991. The applicant did not appear as scheduled.


CONCLUSIONS

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended on January 11, 1991, denial of the application of Rodney D. Aders.

RULING

The application of Rodney D. Aders is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller and failed to demonstrate a sufficient knowledge of the regulation.
