INTERIM RULING
GRANTING PETITION
3819

On July 29, 1991, the United States Department of Energy, Office of the Solicitor filed a petition to intervene in the Matter of Application 51415, filed with the Nevada State Engineer.

The Truckee canal having been historically used to transport said water and the place of use having been historically within the Newlands Project Boundaries, the State Engineer finds that the United States is an interested party and should have full standing in this matter.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that said petition is hereby granted and the United States shall have full standing to present evidence and examine witnesses in the matter of Application 51415.
