R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 18447 was filed to appropriate 7.0 c.f.s. of the waters of Hobart Creek at a point within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 32, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on April 1, 1960, by the Marlette Lake Company on grounds that the waters of Hobart Creek are fully appropriated.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that there is no water subject to appropriation in Hobart Creek at the point of diversion proposed in Application No. 18447.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 18447 is herewith sustained and the application is denied on grounds that there is no water subject to appropriation in Hobart Creek at the point of diversion proposed in said application, and that its granting will impair the value of existing rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
