RULING # 3918

FINDING OF FACTS

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by James W. Cusack in the office of the State Engineer on February 20, 1992, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 11197 was issued to Layne-Western Company, Inc. for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on February 20, 1992. References were received from four of the requests. The applicant was notified on March 18, 1992, by certified mail, to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 10, 1992, at 10:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Layne-Western Company, Inc. on March 20, 1992.¹ Mr. Cusack telephoned and requested a Carson City time instead, and was orally set for April 9, 1992, at 10:00 p.m. in Carson City.

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of James W. Cusack on April 9, 1992.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of James W. Cusack is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
