FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by William G. Mounts in the office of the State Engineer on April 18, 1989 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 9674 was issued to Bible, Hoy, Miller, Rachok & Wadhams for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on April 18, 1989. References were received from four of the requests. The applicant was notified on May 2, 1989 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 19, 1989 at 10:30 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was returned marked "Unclaimed" on May 22, 1989.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The State Engineer finds that the certified mail was correctly addressed to the applicant and recommend denial of the application of William G. Mounts.¹

RULING

The State Engineer hereby denies the application of William G. Mounts on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
