FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Frank Bergwall in the office of the State Engineer on March 10, 1989 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 9655 was issued to Dee Gold Mining Company for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on May 2, 1989 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 19, 1989 at 1:30 P.M. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about his drilling experience the Board finds that the applicant is not a hands-on driller and recommends denial of the license as being essentially unnecessary.² The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Frank Bergwall on May 19, 1989.

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Frank Bergwall is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
