FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by John William Turner III in the office of the State Engineer on August 15, 1995 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13379 was issued to Turner Explorations Inc for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on August 16, 1995. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on December 8, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 11, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Ted Turner on December 11, 1995.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of John William Turner III on January 11, 1996.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of John William Turner III is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
