RULING #4549

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Bryan Immenschuh in the office of the State Engineer on October 15, 1996, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13991 was issued to Elsing Drilling & Pump for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on October 17, 1996. A response was received from four of the individuals. The applicant was notified on December 19, 1996, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 16, 1997, at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The applicant appeared as scheduled and failed Part I of the examination.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant was notified on March 18, 1997, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on April 10, 1997, at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. This examination was timely cancelled.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant was notified on June 18, 1997, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on July 18, 1997, at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada and was advised that if he did not take this examination or failed the examination, the Board would recommend that his application be denied. The Certified Mail receipt was signed by Arnold Elsing on June 20, 1997.<sup>1</sup> On July 17, 1997, Mrs. Immenschuh telephoned to cancel the examination and was told a new application would be needed if he wanted to be examined for a license.

The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Bryan Immenschuh on July 18, 1997, because this was the third time Mr. Immenschuh was scheduled for an examination and did not show.<sup>2</sup>




