FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by George A. Moke, Jr. in the office of the State Engineer on April 9, 1997 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 14022 was issued to Arnold H. Zwankhuze for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on April 10, 1997. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on January 15, 1998 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 12, 1998 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Sandie S. Corning on January 20, 1998.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of George A. Moke, Jr. on February 12, 1998.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of George A. Moke, Jr. is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
