Applications Nos. 18096 and 18923 were filed in support of Desert Land Application No. Nevada - 053834. On April 10, 1960, we were notified by the Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, that they had closed the land application. As of the date of this ruling, the applicant does not have control of the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use.

RULING

Applications Nos. 18096 and 18923 are hereby denied on grounds that the applicant does not have control of the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use, and that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
